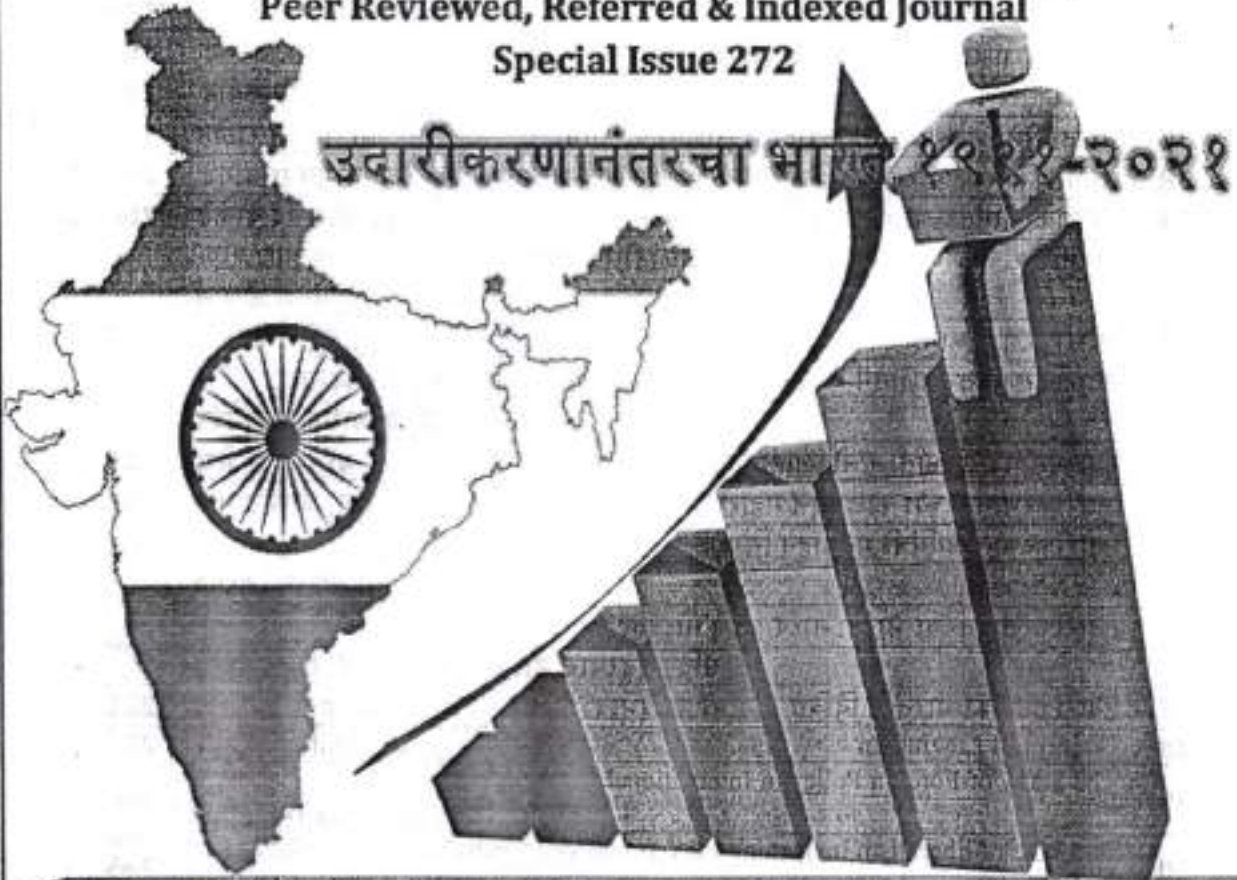

The Role and Limitations of the Central Bureau of Investigation in Curbing Corruption: A Critical Study

Abstract:

Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) is a central government investigating agency which has recorded successes in investigating the political scandals involving the corruption of political office holders from bottom to top. Centre and some state governments accorded such status and invoked the agency to investigate the government involved bribery. Many times, the centre is used by the CBI to intimidate political opponents and state governments which do not toe their line.

The CBI is an extra constitutional body and a non-statutory body as well. It derives its power from the Delhi Special Police Establishment Act, 1946 (Sharma & Agrawal;2020:01). The CBI comprises the Director, who must be a member of the Indian Police Service (IPS), as its head. Then there is a Special Director or an Additional Director to assist the Director in his works. The Supreme Court in 2003 gave recommendations and on the basis of which the appointment of the Director was made more transparent than before (Anando;2018:20).

The role of agency nowadays is not only restricted to bribery and corruption cases by the central and state Government employees but the same is also known to investigate dangerous crimes, high profile cases of Bollywood, Tollywood, and top industrial class, financial crimes including other cases of corruption. It works under the superintendence of the Department of Personnel, Ministry of Personnel, Pension & Public Grievances, Government of India. This ministry falls under the prime minister's office. However, for investigations of offenses under the Prevention of Corruption Act, its superintendence vests with the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC).
