Introduction:

Marriage is the unique bond between two people that links them together emotionally, spiritually and sexually in a union based on common values, love and commitment. Theextra marital relationship can fracture this intimate bond. The reasons behind are diverse such as transferring of emotional energy or career or outside interests or friends. Under these conditions people may re-connect emotionally and spiritually with someone outside of their relationship by fulfilling ones need for acceptance and understanding.2

Extra Marital Relationship:

According to Helen Fisher, a biological anthropologist, "Love is not really an emotion but more of a brain system. When it comes to love, we have three brain systems - first is the sex drive, second romantic love and third, partner attachment. And the brain architecture works in a manner that while being attached to one partner, we can feel intense love for another and sex drive for even more partners".5

According to Ramon Llamba, life and soul coach, "Different people react differently to extra marital affairs. Following are the kinds of extra marital affairs or relationship-
